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In the fast paced and ever changing landscape of industrial relations it can be easy to overlook the emotional consequences for those leading and experiencing it. Emotions in the workplace are highly varied; they affect actions and thoughts; they are contagious; and they are not always what they seem. What we do know is that emotions can have positive and negative outcomes and that often resilience is the factor that tells us how well individuals are coping with the stresses of work.

Professor Peter Jordan's research finds that individuals who can make sense of their own and other's emotions and manage those emotions at work will be under less stress themselves and better able to reduce stress and anxiety in the teams they work with. In this presentation, he will explore the causes and outcomes of emotions for IR practitioners and examine ways in which resilience can smooth out the emotional rollercoaster.

Professor Peter Jordan

Peter Jordan is a Professor of Organizational Behavior and the Deputy Director of the Work Organization and Wellbeing Research Centre at the Griffith Business School, Griffith University, Australia. He gained his PhD in Management at the University of Queensland. Peter's current research interests include emotional intelligence, emotions in organizations, team performance and employee entitlement in organizations. Peter has published extensively in this field in leading international journals and has been awarded significant funding from the Australian Research Council for research in the area of emotional intelligence. He is currently an Associate Editor with the Australian Journal of Management and is a Past President of the Australian and New Zealand Academy of Management. Prior to entering academia he worked for the Commonwealth Government in a strategic and operational planning role.
