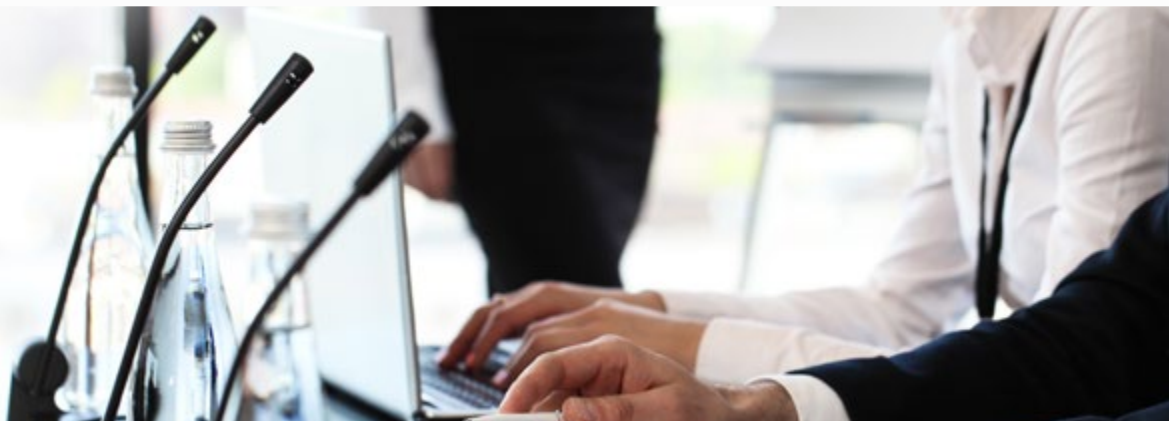


AN EXCLUSIVE IRSQ MEMBERS-ONLY EVENT

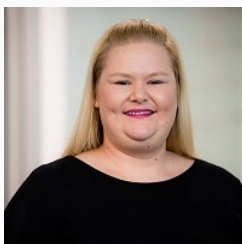
