As Minister for Employment and Workplace Relations Tony Burke has introduced 10 days of paid family and domestic violence leave, passed the Secure Jobs, Better Pay laws to improve Australia's bargaining system and passed the Closing Loopholes laws to improve wages, conditions and safety for workers.

As Minister for the Arts Tony Burke launched Revive - Australia's first national National Cultural Policy in a decade - reversed cuts to the arts and properly funded Australia's cultural institutions like the National Gallery of Australia.

Previously as Environment Minister in the Gillard Government Tony was responsible for resolving 100 years of conflict in the Murray-Darling Basin, placing Tasmania's forests on the World Heritage list and making the second-largest conservation decision in the history of the planet by protecting our oceans.
